ORIGIN OF NAME

Doring Bay is the home location for the Fryer's Cove Winery. The actual winery is perched on the jetty that juts into the cold South Atlantic Ocean. The unique winery building is an old Crayfish factory, and our winery, as far as we know is the only winery built on the sea in the world!

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The season started off with some weather fluctuations which influenced bud break and flowering and causing less and uneven loose bunches with small berries. Despite the challenges and recovering from the severe drought the wines shows good acidity levels and very nice flavour profiles. Phenolic ripeness occurred at lower sugar levels resulting in lower alcohol wines.

WINE DESCRIPTION

It screams at you! "Sexy gorgeous colour, fresh, crisp, Strawberries, gentle Raspberries, dry moreish elegance – Please enjoy me now!" We think it does! Perfect on a hot day or a beautiful sunset! We want you to crack a bottle, enjoy the deliciously inviting gentle strawberry fruits and a hint of the sea, backed up with a mouth-watering balanced dryness, that just slips down. This is our first ever special Pinot Noir Rosé and there aren't many of them around. Enjoy!
